Original, unpublished papers are invited for presentation in the conference. Some selected and peer reviewed papers will be published in SCI and Scopus-indexed journals. The papers for the conference should preferably be typed in LaTeX format. The abstract of the paper may kindly submit in Google form by November 15, 2025.

The academic sessions will consist of plenary lectures, invited talks by eminent Mathematicians and contributed papers by young researchers in various technical sessions.
